We have read the Constitution, Rules and Principles and agreed to abide by them. We understand that we can use the AUHS logo only with the word "affiliated" underneath it, and that we may quote the charity number only in the phrase "affiliated to The Association of Universal healer & Spiritualists, Charity No 1014604", we should not claim this is our own charity number held in the name of our group.

We understand that the AUHS has no control over the internal affairs of the management of any affiliated body, provided the affiliated body does not act in a manner likely to bring the AUHS in particular, or Spiritualism in general, into disrepute. The AUHS retains the right to disaffiliate any group not adhering to these conditions. The AUHS will provide advice and support if required at any time to any affiliated body.

We agree to pay our annual affiliation fee, along with any healer leader fees that may be relevant, by 1st January each year. (The amount as set by the membership at the AGM).

In accordance with the Constitution we will nominate up to two representatives to attend and vote at the AGM and other meetings as requested by the Association of Universal Healers and Spiritualists.

We enclose a copy of our rules.

Some churches and centres seem to have problems understanding what rules they should have. To help you we have compiled a list of questions you should answer. If you do not currently have any written rules the answers to these can be used to compile them. All affiliated groups must have a written set of rules on file at AUHS head office and in their own paperwork.

Object: What is the purpose of the centre/church? eg to further knowledge of spiritualism in the local area or to offer healing to those who need it.

- 1) 1) Who is in charge of the centre/church?
- 2) 2) Is it an elected committee or designated trustees? If it is designated trustees then include the name of these trustees. How long do they serve? In the case of an elected committee is it for one year or two years or more before re-election? In the case of trustees is it for a period of time or for life.
- 3) 3) If trustees run the centre with no pre determined re-election or resignation date, what happens if they leave/pass in to spirit?
- 4) 4) Who is responsible for the money taken in and for paying the bills?
- 5) 5) Where will the money be kept/ ie building society current account, tin under the bed.
- 6) 6) What happens if they leave/pass in to spirit?
- 7) 7) Who can withdraw money? ie how many signatures and who?
- 8) 8) What happens if they leave/pass in to spirit?
- 9) 9) What is the money to be used for?
- 10) 10) Are there any other co-opted (not elected) helpers with specific jobs to do? If so, who/what?
- 11) 11) Who makes the decisions regarding the day to day running of the centre?
- 12) 12) Do you have a paying membership?
- 13) 13) Do you have any sort of membership or congregation meeting to confer on the running of the church?
- 14) 14) If there is a disagreement who has the final say? ONE PERSON ONLY!
- 15) 15) How often do you meet? (times, days)
- 16) 16) Do you always meet in the same place?
- 17) 17) Who is responsible for investigating complaints?
- 18) 18) Who is entitled to use the name of the centre, and therefore the AUHS logo?

Finally, have you made sure your rules cover you from being taken over by any unwanted individual or group? As far as the AUHS and Charity Commission are concerned, we are mostly interested in how the money taken is protected, what the purpose of the centre is, who is in charge (ie ultimately responsible in law) and who do complaints go to? The rest of the suggestions above are to protect you from those who might wish to take over or close you down.

We hope this helps you. Please let us have a copy of rules of some type as quickly as possible **AS YOUR APPLICATION CANNOT BE PROCESSED WITHOUT THEM**

Once you have registered a set of rules with us you are required to advise us in writing of any changes later made.
